# INDUSTRY OVERVIEW

Electronic products occupy a prominent position in the import and export trade of Hong Kong, accounting for 68.3% of Hong Kong's total exports in 2018. According to HKTDC industry research, parts and components constitute about three quarters of Hong Kong's electronics exports, the majority of which are re-exported to the Chinese mainland for outward processing production.

68.3% of Hong Kong's total exports in 2018

Capitalising on the opportunities presented by the development of the Greater Bay Area, most Hong Kong manufacturers have relocated their production facilities to the Chinese mainland to reduce cost. Their Hong Kong offices now focus mainly on R&D activities, product design and development, management, logistics support, marketing, etc.


